Background:

Ma Mawi Wi Chi Itata Centre is currently seeking two individuals for the Yellow Shawl, Student Housing Mentor positions. One within the Female Residence and one within the Male Residence. This program is a partnership between the Ma Mawi Wi Chi Itata Centre and Community Education Development Association (CEDA) and will phase in a structured independent living program for up to 14-youth between 16 to 21 years of age. The innovative youth housing program focuses on providing safe and supportive housing with a continuum of structure and supervision, ranging from peer support to more direct staffing involvement in daily activities. The Mentors will be mature adults, responsible for providing general stability, care of the home and direct support and intervention with youth, as needed.

Position Information:

Mentors are contractors, paid \$1,500/month and have their own room with no rent cost. However, food and personal items are the Mentors own responsibility. Mentors are required to be in the home, when youth are present (morning, evening/weekends) and are provided respite one weekend per month. This position does support time to attend school/university and have another part-time job if the functioning of the home for youth is not compromised. As a contract position, there are no employee benefits.

Qualifications:

- Experience working with Indigenous youth and their families.
- Establishing trusting relationships with youth to improve their health and well-being.
- Ability to use strength-based and solution-focused and non-judgmental approaches.
- Ability to take initiative and to take direction and work well in a team setting.
- Flexibility to workdays, evenings and weekends as may be required.
- Proficient in MS Office applications and basic skills in database, email, and social media.
- Understanding of Indigenous customs, experience, traditions, and values is an asset.
- Current First Aid/CPR certification.
- Valid Class 5 Manitoba Driver's License and access to a vehicle is considered an asset.
- Subject to a Criminal Record Check, Child Abuse Registry and Prior Contact checks.
